



Vivian Elaine Marquardt

November 22, 1943 - April 19, 2011

Vivian Elaine McDowell Marquardt, 67 , of Falmouth, passed away on Tuesday, April 19, 2011, at her home. Born on November 22, 1943 in Neave, Kentucky, she was the daughter of Shelby McDowell and the late Mabel Austin McDowell, who preceded her in death on March 21, 1977. She retired from North Key Community Care after 27 years of service, and she was a member of St. Francis Xavier Church and the Ladies Auxiliary of the Falmouth Volunteer Fire Department.
