Zechariah Lee Gregg, 25, of Falmouth, KY, passed away on Monday, January 20, 2025 at the Bourbon Community Hospital in Paris, KY. Born on May 17, 1999, he was a son of Jackie Gregg Cornett and the late Troy Gregg. Zech's soul was an old one, perfectly captured, at the age of 16, in this high school photograph. Naturally gifted at sports, he and his father practiced faithfully until his baseball game was at it's best. Though he lost his father far too early, he always cherished the many memories they shared. We, today, share Zech's memory, who likewise has left us in the summer of his life. As we take him to his rest today, we have endless, happy memories to assuage the pain of his absence. Zech was a friend to many, but his family remained the central focus of his love and energy. His Mom, Jackie, sister, Desiree, and brother, Brandon constituted the safe harbor he could always return to; and he loved being an uncle to Gabe, Lily and Lexi. 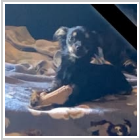
